This year we are offering our best seed package yet, showcasing some of the world's top genetics. We are offering a limited number of proven and promising seeds for sale individually, as well as our Mix & Match Packages!

Prices are in Canadian Dollars. For our American customers, the weak Canadian dollar will give you additional savings. To get your cost in USD on individual seeds, add the shipping charges and divide by 1.38, and round up to nearest \$.

Shipping Charges: Standard Mail to within Canada and the US is \$5. International \$10 CDN. For Premium shipping to the US with tracking add \$10 USD to the above total.

This year's pumpkin seed promo includes **20 seeds** from the top pumpkins at Canada's weigh-offs, including 3, 2000+ lb. seeds! Each set is \$120 Canadian funds, plus \$5 per order shipping and handling for a total of \$125 CDN for standard delivery to Canada and the US (*No Tracking*). (90 USD for our American customers).
