2480 Graham ’22 (*1832.5 Graham x 2294.5 Noel*) 7% heavy. 490” OTT. Heavy, tall, round & orange pumpkin named “Bear Swipe.”

1483 Graham ’22 (*2294.5 Noel x 1832.56 Graham*) Orange with smooth skin. Pollinated by the plant that grew the 2480!

1393.5 Graham ’22 (*2200 Geddes x 1832.5 Graham*) Again, pollinated by the plant that grew the big one.

Yet another genetic line which is set up to grow big, orange, heavy pumpkins!

1832.5 Graham ’20 (*1938 Sperry x 1339 Graham*) 5% heavy. Grew the 2480 Graham ’22! Bright orange pumpkin.

2009.5 Mendi ’22 EST DMG (*2183.7 Mendi x sibb*) – Want to grow a 2183 but don’t want to spend \$500 to do it? This is a great alternative. This pumpkin featured the classic, super-wide 2183 Mendi shape!

805 Mendi ’22 (*1885 Werner x 2183.7 Mendi*) – Reuben’s 150 square foot plant. \$1000+ worth of genetics crossed together here to provide you with the opportunity to grow a personal best!

Lot 43. Grown Once - 2359 Pounds!

326 Ritter ’21 (*2200 Geddes x 1501 Vander Wielen*) Grew the 2359 Geddes ’22 which was 504” OTT!

Lot 44. Amelia’s Big Red!

2006 Wolf ’22 (*2365 Wolf x sib*) 9% heavy. Pollinator was the plant which grew the 2493 Wolf. Even better color than the 2493. Because of the diversity of the sib cross, this could be a better seed than the selfed 2493!

Descendants of the 2365 Wolf will change giant pumpkin growing. In the past, big & ugly was the way to win contests. In the next few years, the 2365 lineage (which produces unbelievably huge, heavy, orange & often smooth-skinned pumpkins) will make people wonder why they used to grow big & ugly pumpkins for competition.

2493 Wolf ’22 (*2365 Wolf x self*) 17% heavy. 473” OTT. Fantastic orange color. Great shape. Heavy. This might be the perfect pumpkin...& many more will follow its legacy. This seed will be grown like crazy & will cost \$500+ after the 2023 season.
